Life Centers Pregnancy Center Opens in Westfield

WESTFIELD—Life Centers, a local non-profit that helps women in unplanned pregnancies, announces the opening of a ninth location in Westfield.

“We are aware of the growing need for free services to women in unplanned pregnancies in Hamilton County,” Brian Boone, Life Centers president and CEO, said. “We’re grateful that now these women, teens and their families will have closer access to our life-affirming outreach.”

The Life Centers’ new space is located at 140 S. Cherry St. in Westfield. It occupies the same building as the Center for Women’s Ministries, a non-profit organization which offers counseling services and clothing at reduced prices.

“This location provides a private setting, comfortable atmosphere, close proximity to local Hamilton County schools, and easy access to U.S. 31 and Highway 32,” Boone said. “Sharing space with the Center for Women’s Ministry is a natural partnership. While these two non-profits remain distinct, the clients who seek out the services of each organization will have a seamless experience.”

At Life Centers’ nine pregnancy resource centers across Central Indiana, volunteers and staff administered more than 20,000 free services last year including pregnancy tests, ultrasounds, confidential peer counseling, 24-hour Help Line calls, maternity support and post-abortion healing groups.

Life Centers previously operated a center in Westfield that served women and families in Hamilton County until that building closed in 2008 with the anticipation of relocation.

“We are excited to have a presence in Hamilton County once again,” Boone said. “Life Centers continues to seek committed volunteers, nurses and physicians who live in or near this growing county and are eager to join us in our life-saving, life-changing mission.”

Community members are invited to the Westfield Pregnancy Center open houses, which will take place Thursday, Nov. 11, 6-8pm and Sunday, Nov. 14, 1-3pm. Visitors are encouraged to bring diaper donations. The Westfield Pregnancy Center is currently open for clients on Wednesdays, 9am-4:30pm.
