“I came in four years ago to the Northeast Pregnancy Center near Pendleton Pike. I thought I might be pregnant, and I had seen the sign for a free pregnancy test. I thought I was going into an abortion clinic. **I was going to have an abortion that day.**

“The counselor gave me a pregnancy test, and I found out I really was pregnant. At that time, I felt like **I was not ready for a child. I was in school and I was scared.** I thought right then that I was not going to keep her, because I've always been pro-choice. I didn't think I was financially ready or mentally ready. I had no cornerstone to lean on because all of my immediate family lives in another state.

“My peer counselor, Candy, spoke to me about the miracle of life. She was confident that I could be a mother. She gave me a Bible, a list of churches, and she prayed for me. She showed me a baby model of how far along I was, which was over six weeks. I had always been taught it was not a fetus yet. **The way that she talked about God and how precious life is inspired me and changed my mind.**

“I chose life for my baby. . . but I was still scared. I kept going to the pregnancy center every other week just to talk to Candy and the whole team of people there all the way until I had my baby.

“**I am pro-life now because of Life Centers.** And now, I have Bethany, who will be three years old next month. She knows the counselors at the Northeast Pregnancy Center by name.

“Just to see the way she acts, her personality, the healing power of a kiss on a boo boo...**If I hadn't gone to the center that day, I would never have met her.**”
